1. 다음을 듣고, 여자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello, Princeton High School students. As you know, our school's website is going to be redesigned. Our goals are to make our website more accessible to everyone and to strengthen online security. To better prepare our new website, we're conducting a survey to gather your opinions and suggestions. Your participation is strongly encouraged. The survey must be completed by this Thursday. For more information, please refer to our school bulletin board. Remember that your input is valuable to everyone in our school's community. Thank you!

2. 대화를 듣고, 남자의 의견으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Kate, you don't look good. Are you okay?

W: Yes, I'm fine. It's nothing.

M: Are you sure? You seem really stressed.

W: Well, I'm having a hard time being the leader of a team project.

M: What's the problem?

W: It's hard handling different opinions because my teammates get into arguments easily.

M: I understand, however, arguments can lead people to make better decisions.

W: Do you really think so?

M: Absolutely! Arguments happen all the time. Try to think of arguments as a way to reach a better decision.

W: That's good advice. I'll try to remember that.

W: It certainly has. Our readers have expressed interest in it, too. What was the idea behind it?

M: The idea was to show contemporary Asia to the public.

W: I see. Are you planning to do any other exhibitions?

M: Yes. I'm planning to do one about contemporary Africa. It will contain paintings featuring people, cities, and homes from around the continent.

W: That sounds great. I look forward to checking it out.

M: You won't be disappointed.

W: Thanks again for your time, Mr. Baker.

M: Yes. I played the guitar and we sang songs together while we sat on the blanket.

W: That star-patterned blanket was our dogs' favorite.

M: Look at our two dogs, Rex and Rover. They look really happy in the picture.

W: Yeah. They started to run around and bark while we were singing. That was so funny.

M: Yeah, that was hilarious! We had such a good time.

5. 대화를 듣고, 남자가 할 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Liz, how are you doing with the preparations for our school festival?  
W: Well, I've just finished printing out the posters. How about you?  
Have you found an MC for the ceremony?  
M: Yes, I reviewed the candidates and chose Brian to be the MC.  
W: Great. He's a good choice. He's always entertaining.  
M: Yes, he is. And the stage is set up for the dance team to rehearse.  
W: Sounds good. I'll arrange the dance team's schedule.  
M: Thank you for coordinating their schedule. What else do we have to do?  
W: Let's see. Well, we invited some graduates this year to come and tell us about their different careers.  
M: That's great. How many graduates are coming?

W: My office is located at 337 Lincoln Avenue.

M: Hmm... I'm sorry, but that's too far for free delivery. We'd have to apply the three-dollar delivery charge.

W: Okay, I see.

M: Alright, let me confirm your order. It was two iced lattes and one hot americano. Is that correct?

W: Yes, thank you.

W: That's okay. Are we still meeting after school for band practice?

M: Of course. See you in the music room.

However, some vegetarians have poorly planned diets, which means their bodies don't get certain essential nutrients. To start with, if you are not getting enough protein, you can get it from beans, green peas, nuts, and seeds. Next, if you aren't getting enough omega-3, it can be found in foods like walnuts, avocados, and olive oil. Third, if you are in need of iron, good sources include tofu, whole grain bread, peanuts, and raisins. Finally, if vitamin B12 is missing from your diet, you can find it in fortified cereals, soy milk, and soy yogurt. By consuming these foods, you'll be getting the essential nutrients you need as a vegetarian.
