- 1. 다음을 듣고, 남자가 하는 말의 목적으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.
  - M: Welcome back to the final episode of *Tomorrow's Singer*. We hope you enjoyed the performances of our two finalists. Now, it's time to pick the winner of our singing competition. Vote now by texting the name of your favorite contestant to the number at the bottom of your TV screen. This is your last chance to help your favorite contestant become a super star. W: Hello, students. I'm sure you've encountered some wild animals in cities. Let's look at some reasons that wild animals have done well and their populations have grown in cities. First, pigeons were rare in cities like Paris, but now you can easily find them. Urban expansion reduced the number of animals hunting them, and food waste in cities has been a great food source for them. And, while London is not by the sea, it has many seagulls. This is because nesting on the roofs of buildings protects their chicks from danger. Next, Delhi is home to about 30,000 monkeys. Experts say that monkeys' high intelligence and comfort with humans let them flourish in the city. Lastly, in the 19th century, there was a small population of squirrels in New York City. Squirrels were seen as public pets, so the city planted nut-bearing trees as their food source. This increased their population in the city. Let's watch a video about these animals' city lives.
